RULES OF "HIGHLAND CREEK IDOL" CONTEST 2010

1. **CONCEPT:** The goal of the judged event is to provide a high quality of singing and entertainment for the public attending the Karaoke Funfest event at the Highland Creek Heritage Festival, on June 19, 2010 and to attract some of the great **karaoke** singers in the Toronto region. It is hoped that the singer will represent a pub or venue, with a view to publicizing and bringing attendees to the event. The event will be judged as fairly and consistently as possible, per the judge's criteria set out below. Greg McConnell is the designated Organizer until further notice. 2. **ENTRIES:** There shall be no more than 18 competitors. "Late" or "day-of-event" singers are welcome, IF there is a slot available. **Advance entries:** before June 12/10, entry fee \$10. **Late or day-of-event entries:** after June 12/10, Entry fee \$20.
 - a. The advance entrants should submit to the Organizer their entry fee of \$10 and any relevant contact information requested. As it is hoped that entrants will represent a pub or venue, the Organizer may request a reference from the pub or its karaoke host. The Organizer must reserve the right to delay acceptance of the entrant until a reasonable time prior to the event, so as to balance the program. If an entrant is not accepted as an advance entrant, his or her fee will be refunded forthwith, and he or she shall remain eligible to be a day-of-event entrant at the reduced \$10 entry fee.
 - b. Any day-of-event entrants should give their entry information to the karaoke host or his representative at the event (between 12:30 and 1:00pm) on the date of the event. On acceptance, the entrant shall immediately pay the \$20 entry fee. If time permits, more day-of-event entrants may be chosen in a number and at a time determined by the host (i.e. later entrants may be accepted).
 - c. **Entrants must be "Karaoke singers"**. Must be 19 or over. Professional singers and (active) karaoke hosts are not accepted. By "professional", we mean a singer who currently earns part or all of his or her living from singing, such as a band singer, or professional opera singer. Day-of-event singers may be asked to provide a reference from their regular karaoke host to confirm that they sing karaoke. Decisions by the Organizer on this issue are final.

3. **JUDGES:** The judges will be designated by the Organizer. The Organizer may rotate judges. There shall be the same judges for any half-hour "set". There will be at least 2 judges each set. We anticipate following the same judging scheme for the 3 sets and final round as follows: 1:30pm - City councillor and staff. 2:30pm - provincial MPP/staff 3:30pm - bankers/contributors 4:30(FINAL) - community organizations. This may change, depending on availability of judges.
4. **CRITERIA:** The judges will be asked to score a performance using the following factors with the following point weights:
 - a. Voice quality (strength, clarity, range etc.): 50 points
 - b. Stage presence (movement, knowing words, holds audience attention, etc.): 20 points.
 - c. **COSTUME: 5 points!!!**
 - d. Audience reaction (during show, and by applause): 25 points
5. **ROUNDS:** Each half hour "set" will be a round, in which a winner is chosen. It is expected that 5 singers will compete in each round, but the host may determine if more or fewer singers will compete. The highest two scored singers of each round will be finalists. The **SIX** finalists will perform a second song in a finalist round commencing at about 4:30pm., and the contest winner will be the winner of that round.
6. **SONGS :** The entrants may choose their song from the repertoire of the karaoke host - Carol and Rob have most of the classic karaoke songs; or, **the singer MAY use his/her own disk**, IF AND ONLY IF the song is a recognized karaoke song from a recognized karaoke label. We ask you to provide the host with the disk at the opening of the set, for set-up purposes.
7. **DISPUTES:** The Organizer, or his appointee, shall settle any disputes, and the decision is final.
8. **CHANGES/CANCELLATION:** The Organizer reserves the right to change the rules or cancel the contest without notice. In that event, the entrants will be refunded their entry fees immediately.
